

Thank you for your interest in our Academy. An International Student Information Packet is enclosed for your use in gaining admission to our school.

We welcome international students to our campus and feel that our climate, concept of training and location provides unparalleled opportunities in comprehensive flight training. Our courses are available online at: <a href="https://www.usflightacademy.org">www.usflightacademy.org</a>.

#### To apply at our Academy you will need to submit the following documents:

- 1. The Form A1-Application for Admission (must be 18 years or older for admittance, or if under 18 years this form must be signed by parent or legal guardian). Include a copy of Passport.
- 2. The Form A2-Travel, Rental car, Living, and Financial Arrangements. Include with this form the \$250 non-refundable processing fee and \$750 refundable security deposit in U. S. funds. Any collection or exchange fee is your responsibility. Payment of this deposit signifies an acceptance of the admission and holds a space for you. Upon physical enrollment, this deposit will be credited towards your tuition.
- 3. The Form A3-Affidavit of Support, must show total course tuition for the course selected, including living expenses for the duration of the course. This form must be filled out by a parent or sponsor and submitted with a bank statement or a tax return. This Affidavit and supporting documents are required. Or, if you are paying your own fees, you may submit a bank statement showing at least this amount in U.S. funds, on deposit, under your name. Be sure all funds are converted into U.S. dollars. These must be original documents.
- Transcripts showing you have completed our level of high school, or equivalent.
- 5. If you are transferring from another institution in the United States, you will need to have your previous school fill out and send, directly to us, the enclosed **TRANSFER CERTIFICATION** form. We will also need a copy of your current I-94 card.

Please note: The U.S. Department of Homeland Security now requires the completion of Form I-901 and a fee remittance of \$200 prior to your appointment for a Visa, and you will also need to submit the flight training request and information via the Alien Flight Student Program (AFSP) website www.flightschoolcandidates.gov and a fee remittance of \$130. Instructions for both these actions are included when the student I-20 is issued. Allow two weeks for processing upon receipt of all required documents.

**International Student** - One who is legally domiciled in a country other than the United States of America at the time of first admission or application to our School.

**I-20 Certificate of Eligibility** - A document for non-immigrant M-1 or F-1 student status, issued by the admissions officer to be used by the student to apply for an M-1 or F-1 Visa to the United States. A person is eligible for an M-1 or F-1 status only if he/she is without intention of remaining permanently in the United States and has adequate financial resources. Training programs are conducted entirely in English.

**Form I-94** - Record of arrival and departure, is normally stapled to a page in the passport. When you leave the U.S., you must surrender the Form I-94.

Affidavit of Support - The document presented by the student to the Academy, with a bank statement, to show evidence of adequate financial resources. Upon satisfactory completion of admissions requirements, the affidavit is attached to the I-20, which may then be presented to an American Consul or Immigration Office to gain an M-1 status.

**Transcript of Credits** - An official copy of the permanent academic record of the student's high school (12 grade equivalency) and/or college grades.

**TOEFL:** Test of English as a Foreign Language, IELTS - or - ESL Compass Assessment Test - Confidential examinations given through procedures designed to protect its security before, during and after its administration. All international applicants whose native language is not English must arrange to take one of these tests and have the official score report sent to the Academy if seeking a degree. Scores over one year old are not acceptable.

A minimum score is 500 (paper based), 173 (computer based), 61 (internet based) for TOEFL, 5.0 for IELTS or 90 for ESL Compass is required for admittance to a Degree program. In addition, all U. S. Flight Academy students will take an English proficiency examination.

**Academy Policy** - All international students entering our Academy with an Immigration status of M-1 or F-1 (student), immigrant or refugee are required to sit for a proficiency examination in the English Language. The result will determine if the student will enroll in the ESL – English as A Secondary Language class – with emphasis on the Aviation Language.



**Scholarship and Financial Aid** - International students are not eligible for scholarships or financial aid through the Academy or the United States Government. Adequate financial resources must be proven by the student through the Affidavit of Support prior to acceptance at the school.

**Training Load** - An international student must complete a minimum of 30 hours per week in a combination of ground school, pre/post flight briefings, flight training hours and lab work, with an average of six hours per day five days per week. (NOTE: You must obtain permission for vacation from the Administration Office).

**Hospitalization and Health Insurance** - It is recommended that international students acquire appropriate medical insurance while in school. USFA have medical insurance available, see <a href="https://www.usflightacademy.org">www.usflightacademy.org</a>.

**Tuberculin Skin Test** - Each international student must independently acquire a Tuberculin Skin Test. The Academy will assist in acquisition of this test. This process will take two to three days to complete. An international student transferring from another institution within the United States may present written results from a previous skin test in place of the above.

**Student Housing -** The Academy maintains student housing in form of shared living quarters with the opportunity to prepare own meals in a home environment. If private apartment is desired the Academy will assist in the location of such. Howard College student dorms are available. See further <a href="www.usflightacademy.org">www.usflightacademy.org</a>.

**Transportation** - The Academy will assist the student in any way possible including transportation to and from the school, and for required personal needs.

#### INFORMATION/INSTRUCTION SHEET

To transfer to U. S. Flight Academy you will need to present to the Administration office:

- 1. Completed Application for Admission \$250 Non-refundable fee required.
- 2. Transcripts from your home country verifying high school graduation or equivalent.
- 3. Affidavit of Support from your sponsor, including his/her bank statement or your own current bank statement (showing on deposit the total amount of support required in U.S. funds).
- 4. TOEFL, IELTS, or ESL Compass scores for a course of study in addition to flight training.
- You will also need to give your previous school the *International Student Transfer Certification* form which they should fill out and send to us.
- 6. Submit to our office a copy of your current/former I-20 copy and your I-94 card.
- Submit a transcript from the transferring school.
